

Student Achievements

- The 2022 Senior Class earned \$3,207,382 in scholarship offerings.
- Four students were named South Carolina Palmetto Fellows for a total of \$116,800 to attend college in South Carolina. Eligibility requirements include at least a 1200 on the SAT or 27 on the ACT, a 3.5 cumulative GPA, and a top six percent ranking.
- Twenty-one students were recipients of the South Carolina Four-Year Life Scholarship for a total of \$420,000.
- Thirty-four students were recipients of the South Carolina Two-Year Life Scholarship for a total of \$340,000.
- Twenty-seven students were recipients of the South Carolina Lottery Tuition Assistance Scholarship for a total of \$123,120.
- Local scholarships totaled \$30,100.
- Nineteen students were Honor Graduates.
- The 2022 On-Time Graduation Rate was 77.9%, while the state average was 83.8%.
- The 2022 College and Career Readiness Metric was 67.6%, while the state average was 65.8%.
- The 2022 Advanced Placement Human Geography Success Rate was 71.4%, while the national average was 53.2%.

Additionally, important information is sent home to parents via Remind, email, social media, website, and digital marquee throughout the year.

Students are able to participate in a multitude of extracurricular activities, including Technology Student Association, Student Council, Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA), Beta Club, Prom Committee, National Honor Society, Athletics, Band, Yearbook, BHS Singers, Garden Club, and Work-Based Learning.
